We were extremely busy in the week before Christmas, enjoying Christmas crafts, the pantomime trip and our Christmas party!

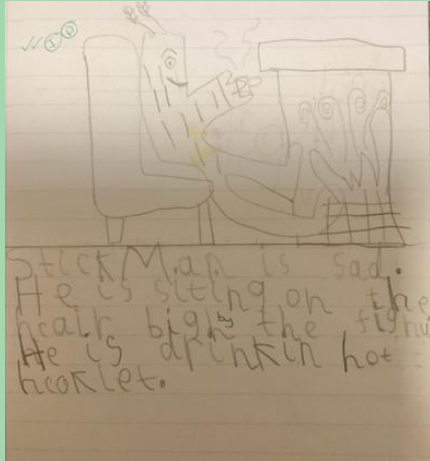

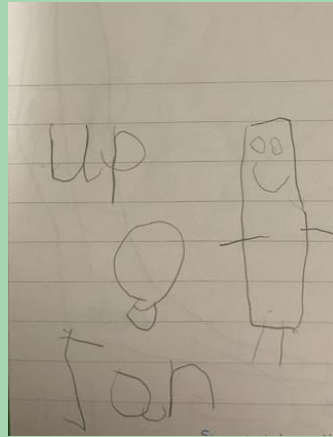


Drawing Club
