

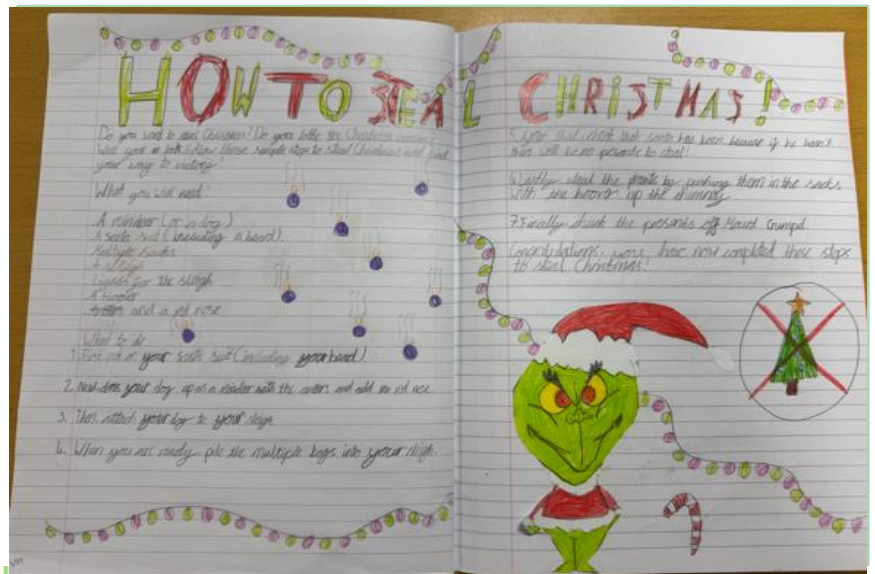
Welcome to Beech Class!

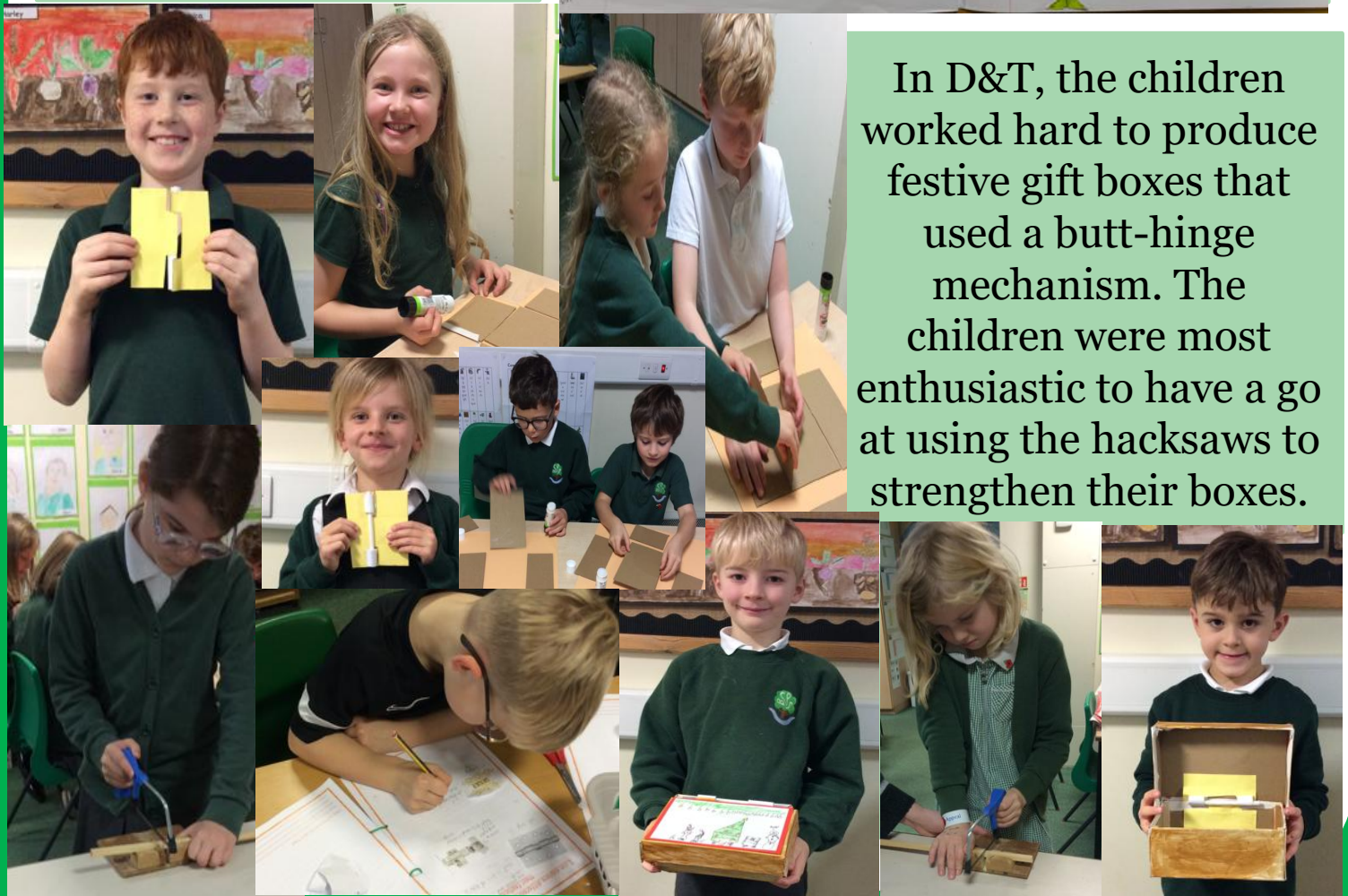

After reading *How the Grinch Stole Christmas*, we were inspired to write some of our own instructions on how best to steal the festive fun!

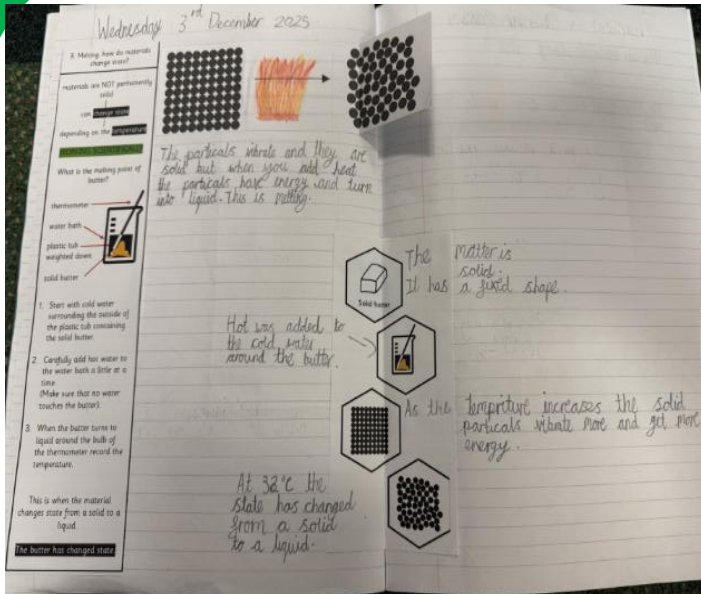

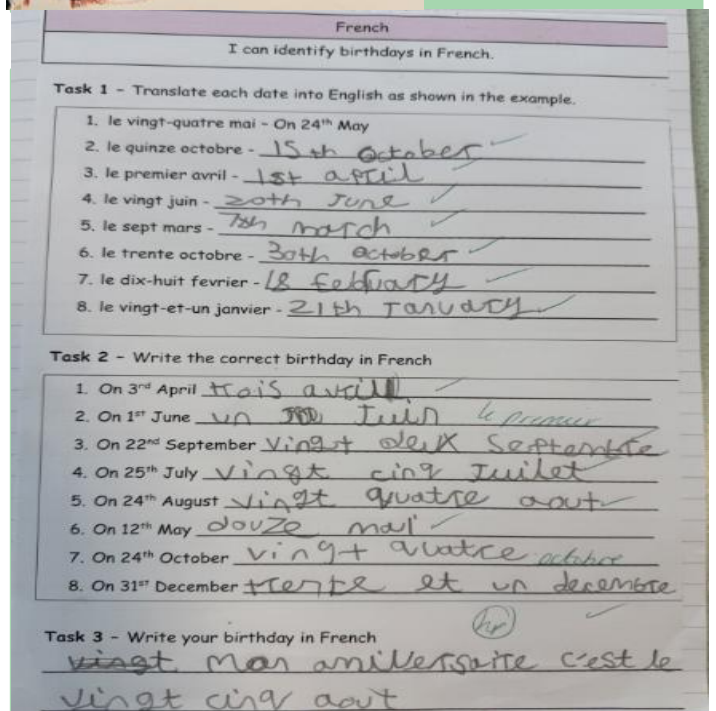
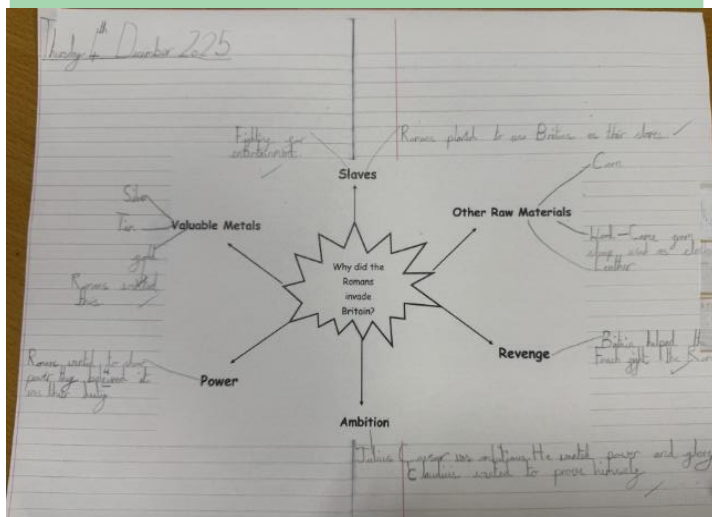


In science, we have been exploring states of matter. We have had lots of discussions around solids, liquids, gases and the processes of evaporation, condensation, freezing and melting.
