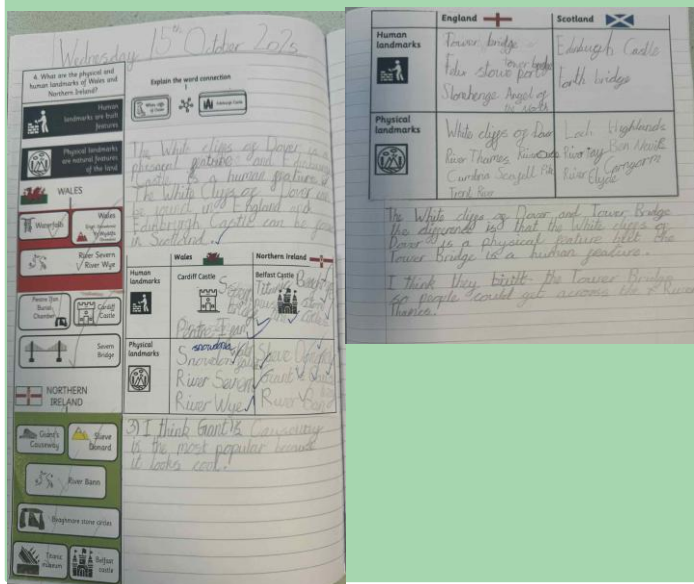
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In Geography, we have made comparisons between each country of the United Kingdom, focusing on human and physical landmarks.
