Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2011/12

The Pupil Premium Grant for 2011 – 2012 was spent on the development of reading skills.

Nature of support 2011/12

- Provision of teaching assistant support in classrooms with Y1 pupil to allow differentiated teaching of phonics and intervention work to take place to ensure progress
- Provision of teaching assistant support time in all classes to ensure that teachers have dedicated time to challenge and support higher attaining pupils in reading
- Purchase of teaching time from a Specialist Teacher of SEN to support the development of basic skills, including reading, for pupils with SEN
- Purchase of reading materials to support the development of reading stamina and higher order reading skills
- Purchase of reading materials for the school library

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The progress of all pupils throughout the school is measured each term. Evidence shows that the spending of the Pupil Premium Grant had a positive impact on pupil standards and progress for most pupils in reading at KS1 and KS2 in 2011 – 2012.
